





NINTH ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING Minutes of Meeting

 3. The Examination committee recommends and the principal move the results passed and the decisions taken in the Result Passing Board meeting conducted on 27.01.2025 are approved.
 4. The Chairperson requested The Chairman, BoS of various programs to move the revised syllabus of R 2024 for the approval of Academic Council.
 5. The Board of Studies of the Department of Aeronautical Engineering recommended the syllabus for VI semester and elective courses offered by the Aeronautical Engineering under Regulation R 2024 for which the Standing Committee recommends and Dr. R. Thirumalai move i) The syllabus for VI semester and elective courses offered by Aeronautical Engineering as in Annexure- I for approval and ii) Be in effect for students admitted from the academic year 2024 – 2025 subsequently under Regulation R 2024 respectively.

Suggestion given by the members

12. The University Nominees, Industry Expert members and Academic Experts appreciated the Principal, Faculty members and Students for receiving funds, Ranks and Awards from various bodies during the Academic year 2024-2025.
13. The University Nominee Dr P Suresh Kumar insisted to include potential opportunities for setting up industry-sponsored laboratories through direct collaboration with relevant industries. Also, Suggested to classify consultancy services into two distinct categories: namely testing-based consultancy and ideation-based consultancy, Requested submission of detailed data related to the Students' Success Index for academic performance analysis and Emphasized the need for documentation of follow-up actions and impact analysis for coaching classes aimed at supporting slow learners.
14. The University Nominee Dr Sujatha Balaraman Requested a detailed list of recruiters participating in campus placements, details of value-added courses offered by various departments and their alignment with industry expectations, data on student awards and recognitions for their societal contributions and outreach activities, also highlighted the necessity of technical staff training programs to enhance laboratory and operational efficiency and Emphasized the importance of structured mentoring systems to support slow learners.

The University Nominee Dr P Visalakshi Recommended routine calibration of laboratory equipment to maintain experimental reliability and academic standards, Asked for documentation on the revenue generated through consultancy activities, highlighting their practical outcomes and institutional benefit, Proposed industry training programs for faculty members, along with a mechanism to record and present the outcomes and impact of such training, Requested detailed statistics on the number of students appearing for GATE and other government competitive examinations and asked for information about alumni contributions, particularly in terms of financial support to the institution in the upcoming meetings.
16. The Academic expert Dr. B.Chitti Babu requested a concise overview of the existing academic regulations and also insisted to share the information pertaining to international collaborations, including partnerships, exchange programs, and research engagements in future.
17. The Academic expert Dr. N.K.Karthikeyan expressed his concern regarding Sought comprehensive details about the placement training programs provided to students.
18. The Industry expert Mr K Keerthivasan showed his concern regarding the declining interest among engineering aspirants in the Mechanical Engineering branch and shows the willingness to support departmental initiatives and particularly those related to curriculum diversification and modernization to align with evolving industry requirements.
19. The industry expert Mr Sivanandhan A suggested the availability of internship opportunities at BHEL, encouraging the institution to facilitate access and coordination for interested students.
20. The meeting was concluded with vote of thanks by Dr P M Balasubramaniam, Member Secretary, and Academic Council.
