

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING**

The 19th Governing Body Meeting of Hindusthan Institute of Technology, Coimbatore, for the academic year 2024–2025 was conducted on 03.01.2025 from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM in the boardroom of the institution.

**1. Introduction of Governing body Members**

The principal of Hindusthan Institute of Technology **Dr.C.Natarajan**, has introduced the members of Governing Body members in the meeting.

**2. To confirm the minutes of the last Governing body meeting held on 15.10.2022**

The minutes from the previous meeting held on 28.10.2023 were reviewed and approved.

**Presentation of the notes of governing body meeting**

**Dr. C. Natarajan**, Principal of Hindusthan Institute of Technology, summarized the meeting notes and reported on the actions taken in response to the comments from the previous governing council meeting.

This included updating the institute's facilities, improving student performance, collaborating with industry through MOUs, internships, and industrial visits, and enhancing faculty involvement through research, journal and book publications, and patent filings. Other aspects considered were the institution's various rankings and budgetary considerations.

- 2.1** The implementation of the **Strategic Plan 2021–2026** and the targets achieved by the institution were reviewed and discussed. The members offered considered, constructive, and valuable inputs to ensure the effective realization of the objectives of the Strategic Plan. **Dr. B. G. Sangameswara** specifically emphasized the need to further enhance training and placement initiatives, highlighting their critical role in improving student employability, industry readiness, and institutional performance in the coming years.

### 3. Requisition of approval

The notes presented are requested for approval from the governing body members

### 4. Discussions

- a) **Dr. S.Y. Kulkarni, Former Vice Chancellor of Reva University**, commended the institution for its significant strides in development and the attainment of prestigious rankings in the previous year. He underscored the importance of fostering robust industry collaborations through exchange programs and advocated for the establishment of an Industry Research Centre and an Industry Advisory Board to facilitate and oversee such interactions. Furthermore, Dr. Kulkarni recommended integrating Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML) techniques into the Teaching-Learning process to enhance the quality of education. He also proposed the development of a data analytics dashboard to systematically monitor and evaluate key parameters of institutional progress.
- b) **Dr. B.G. Sangameswara, Former Vice Chancellor of JSS Science and Technology University**, proposed NPTEL courses as self-study components for students. He recommended a structured evaluation of faculty R&D performance through one-on-one interactions and assessments. Dr. Sangameswara further emphasized the need for targeted measures to enhance end-semester result performance. Additionally, he highlighted the importance of offering German language training to support the growing trend of graduates pursuing higher education at German universities.
- c) **Dr. Pramasivam, Professor, Department of Aerospace Engineering, MIT Campus, Chennai**, inquired about the details of students qualifying in the GATE examination. He recommended initiating focused training programs for students aspiring to appear for Administrative Service examinations. He further sought information regarding the operational effectiveness of the Grievance Redressal Cell and the POSH (Prevention of Sexual Harassment) Cell. Dr. Pramasivam emphasized the need for a detailed presentation of the institution's five-year Strategic Plan accompanied by a comprehensive SWOT analysis. Additionally, he suggested including an outline of the institution's general facilities, such as hostel accommodations, to provide a holistic perspective.
- d) **Dr. N. Nandha Kumar, Professor, Department of Mechanical Engineering, Government College of Technology, Coimbatore**, inquired about the courses available at the institution on Startups, Innovation, and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR). He recommended appointing a consultant to facilitate the patent filing process and suggested the annual collection of research innovation reports from all faculty members. He further

emphasized the importance of registering patents as a tangible outcome of SEED money projects awarded to individual faculty members. Additionally, Dr. Nandha Kumar proposed showcasing posters and banners highlighting recent research achievements within the campus to inspire and motivate both students and faculty members.

5. The subjects listed in the notes submitted for the governing body meeting were approved by the members
6. The Governing Body Meeting came to an end at 1.00 PM with Vote of Thanks given by **Dr. A. Jameer Basha**, Professor and Head, Department of Computer Science and Engineering , Hindusthan Institute of Technology
